MERIT SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

1. Personal Eligibility of Applicant

- Applicant must be a born again Christian.
- Applicant must meet all normal admissions requirements of Hobe Sound Bible College as specified in the current catalog.
- Applicant must enroll in a B.A., A.A. or A.S. program with the intent to graduate from HSBC. He/she must be enrolled for two or four consecutive years, depending on the program, and for consecutive semesters until the degree is completed.
- Applicant, after enrolling, must maintain a satisfactory academic and social standing as explained in the college catalog and the student handbook.
- Applicant must have at least a cumulative high school average of C+ (82-84%) or a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5. A college transfer student must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5.

2. Scholarship Award Information

- This is a two-year scholarship and is awarded only to a first-time freshman or to a transfer student who has not previously attended Hobe Sound Bible College. The student must be full-time with at least 12 credit hours per semester.
- The student must maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.5. If the student fails to maintain this GPA at the end of each semester, or fails to meet all other criteria, he/she may forfeit the scholarship. Freshmen, who fail to maintain the 2.5 GPA at the end of his/her first semester of enrollment, will have one semester of probation with the benefit of the scholarship. If at the end of the second semester of enrollment, the GPA still does not meet the 2.5 requirement, a semester's probation will be given without the benefit of the scholarship. If the GPA requirement is met after the second semester of enrollment, the scholarship will be reinstated. If not, it will be forfeited for the remainder of the award time. This does not apply to transfer students or upperclassmen. Transfer students and upperclassmen will be given one semester of probation without the benefit of the scholarship, after which the scholarship will be reinstated or terminated. Only one probation period is allowed for transfers and upperclassmen.
- This scholarship is for \$1,000 per year (\$500 per semester), and will be reflected on the student's account each semester as long as he/she qualifies. The scholarship is for two years.
- If the student takes less than 12 credit hours, drops out of a degree program, withdraws from school, or fails to maintain all the criteria, the remainder of the scholarship may be forfeited.
- This scholarship is not valid with any other academic based scholarship.
- No student can receive scholarships in excess of his/her need level as determined by Title IV regulations. At no time will cash awards be given.

3. Application Procedure

- The scholarship application and any supporting documents must be submitted to the Admissions Office no later than August 1st. Any applications postmarked later than August 1st will not be considered.
- A formal scholarship cannot be awarded until the student has applied for admission and been accepted as a student to attend Hobe Sound Bible College.
